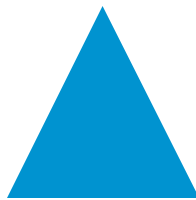

Rules for Participation

Submissions:

All entries must address a current issue as it relates to problems encountered in the Emergency Department OR an interesting and pertinent study. Issues can span a wide spectrum; from staffing, overcrowding, diversions and flow, to caring for everyday medical problems. The goal is to educate and point out successes as ideas for other departments to consider.

Posters should be in a abstract format, outlining the problem, proposed goal of new idea, implementation, data, outcomes, and summary. It should also include entrant's name, title, hospital affiliation, contact phone number and email address.

An electronic version of the poster will be included in the conference syllabus. Send this submission to Shannon McDonald at WA/ACEP by May 1, 2009 in a MS Word or Adobe PDF format for inclusion in the syllabus.

Final posters should be on standard 22"X28" poster stock — no more than two per poster entry. No more than two entries per person.

One need not attend the conference to submit an entry, however, entrants are responsible for setting up their own poster at the conference.

The winning poster will be voted on by conference attendees during the conference. The poster award will be presented at Lunch on Friday, May 29, 2009.

Be Creative...

Poster Set Up and Removal:

Posters will be displayed in the conference exhibit area at Bell Harbor International Conference Center in Seattle, Washington. Attendance at the poster display during break and lunch times is encouraged, but not required. It is recommended that you register for the *Emergency Medicine Without Borders* conference to have full access to the exhibit and poster area to answer questions and discuss the content of your poster with those in attendance.

Posters Removed: Friday, May 29: 1:30 PM

A 4' x 8' display board will be provided for your presentation. Pushpins will be provided on-site. Please note that other materials (i.e., balloons, etc.) may not be attached to your poster or the poster display board.

Posters must be set up and removed promptly. WA/ACEP and WA-ENA are not responsible for damage to posters during set up, display or removal.
